<p><b>As writers:</b> we will use our class text to help us retell a story. Using Talk 4 Writing, we will plan, and edit our stories to include story structure and features such as expanded noun phrases, prepositions and adverbs.</p> <p><b>As readers:</b> we will be inspired and influenced by the story of The Twits by Roald Dahl. We will investigate the vocabulary used in the book and focus on the different VIPERS strands each week.</p> <p><b>As mathematicians:</b> we will revise our addition and subtraction skills before looking at the place value of numbers up to 1000. This will include ordering and comparing numbers, and using them on other contexts such as measuring and time.</p> <p><b>As scientists:</b> we will be investigating Animals including Humans. We will discover why a balanced diet is important, what would happen if humans didn't have skeletons, as well as investigating the role of muscles in our bodies.</p> <p><b>In RE:</b> our theme is Domestic church: Family. We will discover God's dream for every family and look at the different meanings and contexts of the word 'Homes'.</p> <p><b>As geographers:</b> we will examine our home country, Amazing England, and the recap the other countries which make up the United Kingdom of Great Britain. We will learn about the various rivers which run through it. We will be able to name these rivers and research other facts about them.</p> <p><b>As artists:</b> we will be inspired by one of the most famous artists in the world, Claude Monet. We will be practising our painting skills and learning new techniques to use with colour. Our journey will be presented in our sketch books, before we create and evaluate a final piece influenced by Monet's style.</p> <p><b>In computing</b> we will look at the importance of E-Safety in an ever-increasing technological world.</p>	Climate, country, geography, physical, human, aliens, teacher, muscles, skeleton, water cycle.
