#### **Correct School Uniform:**

- Blue Jumper or Cardigan
- Gold Polo-shirt
- Grey Trousers
  - Black shoes ONLY
  - Grey skirt or Pinafore
  - Blue/Yellow Summer Dress
  - Grey or Black socks/tights
  - Blue Fleece (to be taken off in inside)

#### **Jewellery Reminder:**

No jewellery should be worn to school, other than simple stud earrings and a watch/Fitbit (not a smart watch). These need to be removed for all PE activities and kept safe by the child at their own risk.
