What time will school start and finish?

All year groups will open doors at 8.40am, apart from Nursery (FS1) who have slightly different timings. Children should be in class by 8.45am for the register. All classes will finish the school day at 3pm.

For the morning nursery sessions, doors will open at 8.30am (We understand if families with older siblings arrive slightly after this time) and finish at 11.30am. The afternoon session will start at 12.00pm and finish at 3pm.

September Arrangements (COVID updates)

As I am sure most of you will be aware the national school COVID-19 guidance has been adapted for September in light of government changes. Although there are some major changes, such as no longer needing bubbles, as a school we still will be cautious in our approach. We will continue to ensure rigorous cleaning, good hygiene, and increased levels of ventilation, where possible.

Face masks will remain in place until the end of the summer term but will no longer be a requirement in September, however, if individuals feel more comfortable wearing a mask when in close contact, we are happy to support this. Please remember we recommend parents wear masks on site until the summer break.

Pupils with symptoms will still be required to isolate and take a PCR test but their class will not close unless advised to by public health. If pupils display symptoms in school, they will be sent home to isolate and book a test. Track and Trace will operate to identify close contacts and may recommend testing of some individuals.

Should any guidance change we will let you know in due course.

- Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 will enter through fire doors as they do currently, and Year 6 will enter through the door next to the classroom. Children will be clear about this before they leave for the summer holidays.
 - When waiting on the playground with your child please ensure you respect anyone who would rather distance from others. Older pupils will be encouraged

to leave parents at the gates/one-way system as currently in place. The one-way system will remain in place for the time being.

> Staff will be on hand to support anyone unsure as to where they should be going.
