
- The Church is the light of the world. It is the duty of the church to spiritually nurture the people and guide them to Christ and heaven.

#### What was your experience during the pandemic?

- It was a very fast learning curve to adjust to new ways of socialising, living, working and communicating a worrying but also exciting time
- Very scared, nursing mum through end of life cancer treatment alone
- Some very positive demonstration of care and kindness in the community. Lots of anxiety though about older and vulnerable family and friends. Did experience some bereavement
- It was good, spent more time with family. Work was easier.
- I live on my own so quite lonely.
- I enjoyed being able to spend stress-free time with my children. My brother also moved in with us to protect our parents and it was really nice to spend time with him as he lives in France. I still worked in the pandemic so I had the best of both worlds.
- I felt sad that my own children and children I taught had such a dramatic change to their lives

#### When you think of the future what are your hopes?

- The Church needs to modernise, it does very little to appeal to young adults. It should also allow priests to marry, this would solve the shortage of priests, ensure we had younger priests and a clergy who can relate to young people. Every church I go into now has old parishioners, there is very little to appeal to a 20-something audience.

# What words would you use to describe your experience of Church and faith?

- Increasingly exasperating. We seem to be continuing to travel down
  the path where rules are more important than people, most often it is
  hard to find the joy in our faith and sometimes it is almost impossible to
  continue to be positive about the Church. it feels like it has lost it's
  purpose.
- It helps a lot of people feel reassured and part of a community, not my experience but was raised as Methodist
- Heavily involved growing up without question, spent a time away as a
  young adult in part due to questioning the values of the church, partly
  not finding the right place to be in a new city. I was not allowed to
  get married in a church which further alienated me for a short time
  but when my children were born, I came back and engaged with the
  church and the local catholic education system.
- Positive well supported in a work environment.
- Education, work
- I have a strong faith and I feel my faith in the way I treat, interact with and help others. However, my experience of church is that it is old-fashioned and out-dated. Although being in church is pleasant in terms of it being peaceful I do not need to go to church to feel close to God.
- Reassuring and comforting in times of trouble or worry about the birth of my first child, distant and that I no longer 'fitted in' when my personal circumstances changed and I experienced a breakdown in my marriage.

- More engaged, more welcoming, more open to different way of exploring and expressing our faith
- Open to all and accepting of all.
- Approachable, welcoming, progressive.
- Accepting of everyone.

- A vibrant, more welcoming, more accepting (to people of all backgrounds) more modern place which is less austere and mysterious to many but welcoming and open.
- Inclusive and forward thinking







#### If Pope Francis was here today what would you like to tell him about how the Church should be after the pandemic?

- Pope Francis knows what the church should be after the pandemic. He has an openness of spirit that is refreshing and can allow for greater acceptance while staying true to the values of our faith.
- He seems to be making progress but we need to address attitudes in the modern world.
- A refuge for all and any who need support, community and a belief
- An open place, willing to listen to ideas form everyone. This is a great start. I like the job the current Pope is doing.
- Kind and inclusive
- I would tell His Holiness that the church needs to modernise, allow priests to marry, move with modern-day thinking, allow all people to feel welcomed in the church, allow those who have divorced to remarry in the church, organise events and trips that youngsters will engage with.
- Welcoming, modern, inviting, inclusive, non-judgemental

## Is there anything else that you would like the Church to know?

- There has to be something more than Mass. There are many ways in which we can all express our faith and almost all the expertise and experience of this lies in lay people
- Church needs to be outward facing, it has to make the people want to come to the church, it needs to be in the schools, in the colleges, it cannot expect people to just attend. The church now needs to put in the hard work for would-be parishioners.
- I felt isolated from the church when my marriage broke down having married in the church, I was grateful for family and friends who supported me as I don't feel I would have had this support at church, I feel saddened that my change in circumstances has resulted in a diminishing of my personal faith as I cannot find support in scripture for the choice I made, I hope to strengthen my faith and feel accepted within the Catholic church despite the choices I have made in my personal life.
